

Starting on Thursday, November 17<sup>th</sup>, a portion of Lions Club Drive (the road in the park) will be closed so that the town can continue with the drainage project in the park.

They will be closing the South end of the road from the Boy Scout building to the pool. That means that you will not be able to enter or exit onto Calumet Avenue by the Boy Scout building or enter or exit onto Fisher from any of our buildings. You will only be able to access the park road from the stop light (between the buildings). At this time, you will still be able to drive between the back of the Weis Center and the Main Church/School building using Lions Club Drive. In short, you cannot use Lions Club Drive (the park road) to get out onto Fisher.

They expect this work to be completed by Thanksgiving. Please consider carpooling to help reduce the amount of cars exiting the parking lot if you do not do so already.

We will keep you posted on their progress.

Please note that the bus that runs between the Weis center and the main building will now pick up at the south end of the Weis Center parking lot and take Calumet Avenue to the main building (instead of Lions Club Drive). Please do not park at the South end of the Weis Center.

**Additionally, please be aware that this part of a multi-phase project and different portions of Lions Club Drive will be closed on and off over the next few months.**
